<u>User Manual for ENR-03: Enrolment of Unregistered</u> <u>Persons (URPs) in the E-Way Bill System</u>


1. Enrolment of Unregistered Persons (URPs):

- As per the notification, Unregistered Persons (URPs) can now enrol in the E-Way Bill system using Form ENR-03.
- To enrol, the option is available under the "Registration" section in the main menu of the E-Way Bill Portal.



2. Accessing the ENR-03 Enrolment Screen:

- After selecting the ENR-03 option under the "Registration" section, the ENR-03 enrolment screen will be displayed.
- This screen allows you to enter the required details to complete the enrolment process.



3. State and PAN Details:

 The user must select their State and enter their PAN details, which will be verified during the process.

4. Enrolment Type and Address Details:


 The user should select the type of enrolment, then provide address details and a mobile number. The mobile number will undergo OTP-based verification.

5. Creating Login Credentials:

The user must create a username, check for its availability,
and set a password before submitting the details.

6. Enrolment ID Generation:

- Upon successful submission, a 15-character Enrolment ID will be generated, and an acknowledgment will be displayed.
- This Enrolment ID can be used instead of Supplier GSTIN or Recipient GSTIN for generating e-Way Bills.
- The enrolled URP can log in to the E-Way Bill Portal using the ID to generate e-Way Bills.



7. Generating an e-Way Bill:

- To generate an e-Way Bill, the user must log in to the E-Way Bill Portal using their username and password.
- Once logged in, they can proceed with generating e-Way Bills using their Enrolment ID instead of the GSTIN.



8. Generating the e-Way Bill:

- The user should select the 'Generate New' option on the E-Way Bill Portal.
- The Enrolment ID will be automatically populated as the Supplier/Recipient.
- After entering all the required details, the user can proceed to successfully generate the e-Way Bill.
